



## Engineer Officer (Fishing Vessel) Class 2 CoC (Exam Route)

### Intended For

Seafarers wishing to attain a certificate of competency as Second Engineer of fishing vessels more than 750kW.

### Entry Requirements

An approved 6 week course of instruction on fishing vessel machinery and 24 months sea service in an engineering capacity on fishing vessels over 100kW, or a full engineering apprenticeship and 6 months sea service in an engineering capacity on fishing vessels over 100kW, or a full engineering apprenticeship and 3 months sea service in an engineering capacity in the Merchant Navy or Royal Navy and 3 months sea service in an engineering capacity on fishing vessels over 100kW, or 30 months sea service in an engineering capacity on fishing vessels over 100kW. Sea service must be verified by appropriate testimonials or references as specified by the MCA. MCA Notice of Eligibility.

### Duration

5 days oral exam preparation, plus additional periods as necessary to complete short courses. 6 week instructional course if this entry option is taken (see above under Entry Requirements).

### Content

Personal Survival Techniques, Medical First Aid, and Advanced Firefighting short courses (unless any course or its previous equivalent has already been completed). Instruction Course in the operation and maintenance of machinery found in fishing vessels if this entry option is taken (see above under Entry Requirements). Preparation for MCA oral exam.





## Structure

Full time study at centre.

## Funding

Funding may be available through Shetland Fisheries Training Association.

## Qualifications

Short Courses, plus Instructional Course if this entry option is taken (see above under Entry Requirements), and a MCA CoC as Deck Officer (Fishing Vessel) Class 2.

## Career Progression

A MCA CoC as Engineer Officer (Fishing Vessel) Class 1, or conversion of qualifications for service in the Merchant Navy.
