



## Master Unlimited CoC (Exam Route)

### Intended For

Deck Officers who attained their Chief Mate (Class 2 or First Mate Foreign-Going) Unlimited CoC prior to 1/1/88 (revalidated to STCW '95) wishing to attain a certificate of competency as Master for vessels of unlimited tonnage in the unlimited area.

Note: Deck Officers who attained their Chief Mate (Class 2) Unlimited CoC after 1/1/88 (revalidated to STCW '95) have already completed all the study requirements for Master Unlimited, and only need to complete the specified sea service and a MCA oral exam for a Master Unlimited CoC, as described in the MCA Deck Oral Exam Preparation Courses leaflet.

### Entry Requirements

Medically fit holding an ENG1 certificate. 36 months sea service whilst holding a MCA STCW '95 Reg. II/1CoC as Deck Officer of the Watch Unlimited CoC, and including at least 18 months whilst holding a Chief Mate Unlimited CoC, which must be completed on seagoing vessels over 24 metres in length or 80gt and verified by appropriate watchkeeping certificates and testimonials as specified by the MCA. A MCA Notice of Eligibility.

### Duration

3 months.

### Content

Studies for a Certificate Of Achievement in Navigation Instrumentation, Engineering & Control Systems, Business & Law, Ship Construction & Stability, Navigation & Passage Planning, and two SQA/MCA written exams in Navigation, and Stability. Medical Care, and Navigation & Radar Simulator (Management level) short courses (unless any course or its previous equivalent has already been completed). Preparation for MCA oral exam.





**Structure**

Full time study at SSNS.

**Funding**

For seafarers not sponsored or employed by a shipping company MCA SMarT funding may be available for payment direct to the seafarer.

**Qualifications**

Certificate Of Achievement in specified subjects, plus SQA/MCA exams, plus Short Courses, and a MCA STCW '95 Reg. II/2 CoC as Master Unlimited .

**Career Progression**

Various positions afloat and ashore in the shipping industry.
