



## Modern Apprenticeship in Engineering

### Intended For

Candidates who wish to pursue a career within various engineering sectors and at various levels.

### Entry Requirements

Candidates must be employed. No formal qualifications are required but candidates should have a good basic knowledge of Maths, English, and Science (preferably Physics).

### Duration

Craft Apprentice - 3 years.

Technician Apprentice - 3 to 4 years.

### Content

Craft Apprentice - National Certificate in Engineering/Electrical Engineering Practice, Performing Engineering Operations SVQ Level II, Engineering Maintenance/Fabrication/Welding SVQ Level III.

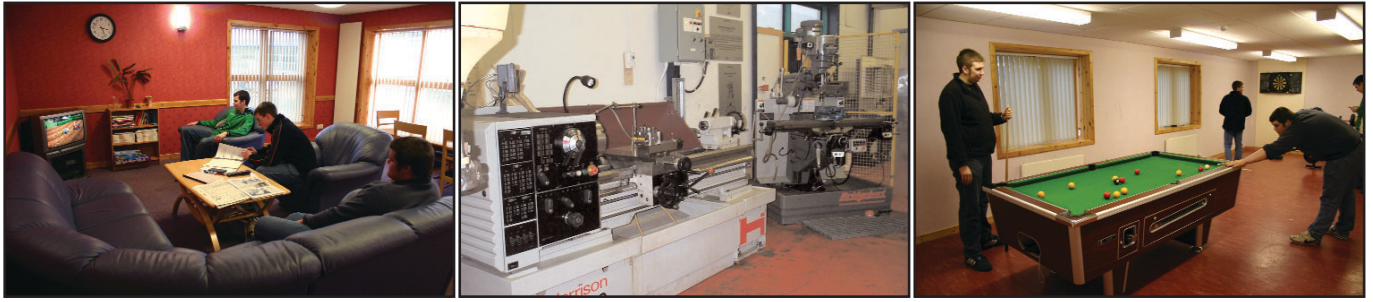
Technician Apprentice - as for Craft, plus HNC Engineering Practice.

### Structure

Craft Apprentice - block release at SSNS of 1 x 13 weeks and 2 x 9 weeks. Workplace experience and assessment in year 3 with attendance at ssns for Portfolio Workshops 1 day per month.

Technician Apprentice - block release at SSNS of 1 x 13 weeks, 2 x 9 weeks, 1 x 5 weeks, 3 x 4 weeks & 1 x 2 weeks. Workplace experience and assessment in year 3 with attendance at SSNS for Portfolio Workshops 1 day per month.





**Funding**

The employer may be eligible for funding through the Modern Apprenticeship Scheme.

**Qualifications**

SEMTA Modern Apprenticeship Certificate.

**Career Progression**

This qualification may lead to entry of the Higher National Diploma and then/or Degree level courses.
